QUICK DRAW COMPETITION RULES:

1. Bring your own art supplies:

Paint (Oil, Acrylic, Watercolor, or Pastel)

Painter's Pallet, Board for Mixing Paints, or Paper Plates For Kids

Canvas (Be sure to bring it blank for stamping before the Quick Draw painting time)**

Paint Brushes

Water and Paper Towels

Standing Easel that can Hold/Display your Painting

Frame for your Canvas (Kids' paintings do not need frames)

Any Tools for Framing

2. Sign-In at the Check-In Table set up along the left side of the Harford County Sheriff's Office on Main St. in Bel Air between 8am-9am on Saturday, October 12, 2019 before the painting period starts at 9am. Each competing artist will receive their identifying number label and get their blank canvas stamped before painting begins. The artist's entry fee can be paid at the Check-In Table or by pre-registering online.

3. Paint only during the painting time from 9:00AM to 11:00AM. We recommend that you paint along Main Street or the side streets close to the Harford County Sheriff's Office.

4. At 11:00am painting stops and artwork is to be framed (adult artists only) and brought to the display area along the left side of the Harford County Sheriff's Office to display on the artist's easel for the Art Sale and Awards Judging: 11:30am-1pm.

5. If someone wants to buy your painting, please direct them to the Check-In Table to handle the sale. Maryland Center for the Arts receives 40% sales commission on all artwork sold to support the continuation of the program. 60% of the sale will be paid to the artist from Maryland Center for the Arts.

6. All artists should be present for the Awards Ceremony 12:30pm-1pm.

7. All paintings must be removed at 1:00pm when the Quick Draw Art Sale and Awards Ceremony ends.
